These trials have an after-closing waiting list. The waiting list will be active until its deadline, Wednesday, August 26, 6:00 pm CDT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run.** Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full. NOTE: Runs from the waiting list may not appear in the exhibitor's catalog due to the late waiting list closing date.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, after the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (ie, Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Bred-By Sweepstakes

Move-ups / Transfers

Herding — Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for herding title, provided that the request is made to the Event Secretary no later than one-half hour before the start of the trial and that there are open runs available in the class. Email notice is acceptable.

Agility — For the FIRST RUN in each event on Wednesday, Sep 2: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CDT, Wednesday, Aug 26. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Thursday, Sep 3 trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trials on Wednesday and must be submitted at the trial. Trial to Trial moveups will be accepted each day. Moveups between trials on the same day close 30 minutes after the completion of the first run of the class and no later than 15 minutes before the start of the second run of the class moved to.

Obedience/Rally — Requests to transfer in class must be made to the Event Secretary no later than one-half hour prior to the start of the trial.

Conformation — Requests to move from a regular class to Best of Breed for dogs whose championships have been completed according to their owners' records but whose championships are unconfirmed must be made to the Event Secretary no later than one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of regular conformation judging.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

The Border Collie Society of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the event cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience, Rally or Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per trial for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Event Secretary must receive written notification by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked at least 30 minutes before the trial commences.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$20 returned check fee.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Event Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed

Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows: "a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve to Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Event Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show." All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. No trophies will be mailed. Remaining trophies become the property of the Club and the Club reserves the RIGHT TO SUBSTITUTE trophies for one of equal or greater value.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Licensed Events. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The Border Collie Society of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s).

Dogs may not be left in the Event Center overnight. Crates may be left.

Herding Trials - A tub for cooling off will be provided.

Agility - Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Dogs may not be left in closed vehicles without proper ventilation. If dogs are found in distress, BCSA will take appropriate action.

Handbills, circulars or any other printed material may not be sold or distributed at these shows except for BCSA printed materials.

No Flexi-leads will be allowed in the building or ring area.

No strollers or playpens will be allowed in the building.

No smoking allowed inside the Event Center.

No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance."

No outside food is permitted at the Event Center.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

The Event Committee reserves the right to remove any roped-off areas and allocate crate and grooming space, if necessary.
