Entry Method

First Received with preference for English Cocker Spaniels. All entries will be accepted on the opening date, but only entries for English Cocker Spaniels will be entered into the trial for the first 2 weeks. All other entries will be put on a waiting list. On April 17 at 8 am CDT, those entries will be entered in the trial in the order received until the trial limits are reached. Entries received on or after April 17 at 8 am CDT will be entered in the trial in order of receipt regardless of breed until the trial limits are reached.

Online Entries

This trial is accepting online entries through **LabTestedOnline.com**. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 165 runs online (50%), 165 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable. No fax entries will be accepted.

Limit of 10 dogs per envelope.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. Please check your entries!

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on May 24. The waiting list will be active until its deadline — Monday, June 5, 6:00 pm CDT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run. Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Class Description

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. **Dogs must** be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

All dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card. You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. Move-ups

For the Friday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CDT, Monday, June 5. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Trial Information

The middle room will be available on **Thursday, June 8** for set up from 5:30 pm - 6:30 pm. Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after the completion of the trial each day.

Ring size: 80' x 100'.

The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space. Please bring chairs, crates and water for your dogs, and clean up supplies.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes.

A MACH ribbon and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a MACH title at these trials. A PACH ribbon and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a PACH title at these trials. A new title ribbon will be awarded to any dog finishing a title at these trials. A QQ rosette will be offered to any dog qualifying in both Master Standard and Master JWW in the same trial.

High in Trial (English Cocker Spaniel) for each day is determined by combined YPS in Standard and JWW classes at the Master level. If no Master level dog QQs, consideration goes to dogs with Standard and JWW Qs at any other level. If no dog qualifies in both, high score goes to the dog with the fastest YPS in either Master Standard or Master JWW. If a tie should occur, the dog in the tie with the most Qs, in all offered classes that day, is awarded HIT.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dogs</u> is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- The English Cocker Spaniel Club of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>written notification</u> of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.
- The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for <u>injured dogs</u>. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's or doctor's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The English Cocker Spaniel Club of America has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and <u>must include the signed</u>
 <u>Agreement and Rules</u>. <u>Junior Handlers</u> must enter their JH# and complete back of form.
 Include only AKC titles on entries.
- All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No" checked
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.
- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- No strollers or playpens will be allowed in the building.
- No Flexi-leads are permitted in the building.
- No professional photography or videotaping is permitted without permission.
- NO SMOKING is allowed in the building.
- Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

Handlers may opt to enter in a *higher height* division for all *Regular* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes *must* compete at the required jump height and *may not* compete in a jump height division *higher or lower* than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an *Agility Jump Height Card* may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the *AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM* may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
