### **Jump Height Order**

Obedience and Rally classes will be run short-to-tall on Friday, tall-to-short on Saturday and short-to-tall on Sunday. Exhibitors entering classes with jumps are required to include their dog's jump height on the entry form. Tall to short will be accomplished with reverse catalog order for all classes.

Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

# **Transfer Information**

Moveups/Transfers will be allowed according to AKC Regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Email notice is acceptable.

### Notice to Exhibitors

- The Great Hall will be available to Obedience/Rally exhibitors on Thursday, January 17 at Noon. The Gateway Hall will be available to Conformation exhibitors for setup on Friday, January 18, from 9 am to 9 pm.
- There are NO night time security personnel on site. NO DOGS will be allowed to remain in the building overnight.
- CRATING & GROOMING: Grooming and crating in designated areas only. Bathing of dogs limited to bathing area, located next to grooming area. No dogs allowed in bathrooms. No Ringside crating in the Great Hall with the exception of the Agility, Obedience and Rally Trials. NO CRATES MAY BE PLACED DIRECTLY ON THE FLOORING SURFACE IN THE GREAT HALL. THERE MUST BE PLASTIC OR A RUG UNDER THE CRATE. ALL GROOMING TABLES MUST HAVE RUBBER OF PLASTIC CAPS ON THE END OF THE LEGS OF THE TABLE. No cones are allowed inside building.
- NO EX-PENS allowed on the blacktop, the grass around the Event Center or in the Event Center. This includes the Gateway Hall.
- All dogs must be on-leash at Purina Farms at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged).
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Rabies Vaccination Certificate Missouri requires you to have proof of current rabies vaccination with you. Tags are not accepted.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows: "a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve to Fifteen Month Class at a show prior to judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show."
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors of their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Obedience and Rally Trials Entries for Golden Retrievers only will be accepted until closing; all other breed entries will be put on a waiting list. At closing entries from other breeds will be accepted into the trial in order of receipt until the limit is reached.
- Refund of entries, less \$10 per trial, for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come <u>in season</u> after the closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a <u>veterinarian's certificate</u> to the Show Secretary <u>by January 23, 2019.</u>
- All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All prizes offered by the Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis are through the generosity of its members and friends.
- All exhibitors MUST abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Event Center. All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.
- PARKING: Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of the Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to one parking space. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. NO day parking on Level A, B, C

or D - RV parking lot. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

Overnight RV parking is by reservation only. Violators will be asked to move or be towed at owner's expense. Refer to information in the RV Parking Reservation section.

RV parking in the upper lot of the Event Center will be available 9:00 am on Thursday, January 17. All RV and Day parking vehicles must vacate the RV Parking area by 9:00 am on Monday, January 23, 2019. Lower RV lot is available Thursday, January 17, 2019.

Handicapped parking is available in areas marked.

ACCESS - A Security Guard will be present at the gate to allow access to the facility from 7 am to 8 pm. From 8 pm to midnight gates are closed, but access to and from the facility is still possible. The exit gate automatically opens to allow guests to leave. A Security Guard will be at the gate each hour, on the hour, during this time to allow overnight guests back onto the premises. 

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel and show grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels or the show site can result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds are considered within the show grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the show-giving club and its Show Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

### **RVs**

RV Hookups are available at Purina Farms next to the Event Center, however due to the time of year, there is no water hookup available. Rate is \$35/night. Use the RV Reservation Form below.

**Reservations are REQUIRED** for all RV's. Any rig not on the RV chair's paid reservation list may be locked with a boot or be subject to being towed at the owner's expense.

Exhibitors will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their spaces. Discharge onto the grounds is not permitted. Anyone abusing this privilege may forfeit future parking spaces and could be subject to disciplinary action by the Event Committee, including expulsion from this and all future trials. Per Purina Event Center regulations, no golf carts are allowed. Towed vehicles may be parked away from the RV parking.
