Requirements for Puppy Sweepstakes

Open to any purebred Golden Retriever, at least six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the show, and which is entered in any of the regular classes at the Specialty Show at which these Sweepstakes are held. AKC Champions of Record are not eligible. The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be limited to the owner, co-owner, breeder, or a member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date of the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. Entry fee is \$18.00. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class".

Classification for Puppy Sweepstakes

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

- Puppy, 6 months & Under 9 months
- Puppy, 9 months & Under 12 months
- Junior, 12 months & Under 15 months

Requirements for Veteran Sweepstakes

Open to any purebred Golden Retriever, eight (8) years of age and over on the day of the show, that is individually registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) or Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). AKC and CKC Champions of Record and neutered or spayed Golden Retrievers are eligible. Entrants need not be entered in any other class. Entry fee is \$18.00. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class".

Junior Showmanship Competition

Open Class - For boys and girls at least 9 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class.

Master Class - For boys and girls at least 9 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won ten the first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition.

NOTE: Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

These events are open to Golden Retrievers which have been registered with the American Kennel Club and are six (6) months of age or older or have an acceptable foreign registration number (subject to restrictions in Chapter 11, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*).

Obedience and Rally classes are open to dogs of all breeds which are six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season may not compete in Obedience or Rally classes.

Move-up Information

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher Obedience or Rally class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an Obedience or Rally title, provided that the request is made to the Event Secretary no later than one-half hour before the start of the trial. Email notice is acceptable.

The Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis and its members and Purina Farms assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

The Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

A Recording Fee of \$0.50 is required for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 is required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. A Recording Fee of \$3.50 is required for first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry. These fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on US accounts or with International Money Orders in US Funds.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

No refund for duplicate entries or for overpayments of less than \$5.00.

Refund of entries for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary by April 9, 2012.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email or telegram prior to close of entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows: "a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve to Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Event Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show."

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors of their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All prizes offered by the Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis are through the generosity of its members and friends.

A complete list of contributors will be printed in the catalog.

Obedience/Rally Trials - Entries for Golden Retrievers only will be accepted until closing; all other breed entries will be put on a waiting list. At closing entries from other breeds will be accepted into the trial in order of receipt until the limit is reached.

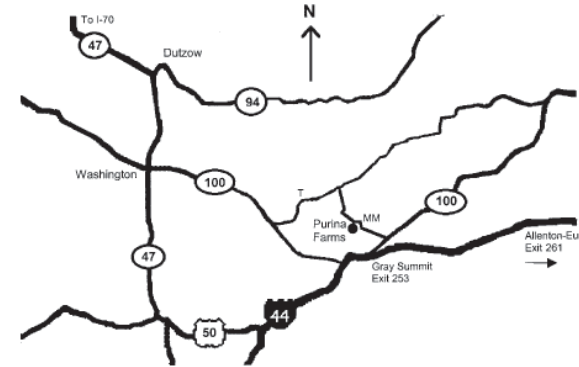
