Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Move-ups

Move-ups will be allowed according to AKC Regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Jump Height Order

Obedience classes will NOT be run in jump height order. Armband assignment will be random. Rally classes with jumps will be run short-to-tall on both days.

A RECORDING FEE of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2). A RECORDING FEE of \$3.50 is required for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry at any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial.

The Greater St. Louis Training Club, Inc. and its members and the St. Louis County Parks Department assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

MAIL ALL ENTRIES with fees several days in advance of closing date as specified herein. Entries must be in Trial Secretary's office by specified closing date and time after which entries will not be accepted, canceled, or altered.

ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise entry cannot be accepted.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

PLEASE PRINT PLAINLY OR TYPEWRITE all information on your entry form to help avoid errors.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing or by e-mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED:

- in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, an act of public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of Greater St. Louis Training Club, Inc.
- for duplicate entries.

POST DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES with checks drawn on U.S. Accounts or with International money orders in U.S. Funds.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable after entries close with confirmation and judging programs. Should such acknowledgement not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable amount of time, please notify Trial Secretary.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed to compete. A refund of the entry fee, less \$8.00, will be made for a bitch who comes in season provided the Trial Secretary is notified PRIOR to the start of the Trial and verified in writing by a veterinarian.

OVERNIGHT PARKING of motor homes and trailers will be permitted only in the lower parking lot on Friday and Saturday nights with permission of the Complex Manager (314-894-3089). No electrical, water or plumbing hook-ups are available.

THE SHOW SITE will be available on Friday evening from 7:00 – 8:00 pm. The building will open at 7:30 am on Saturday and Sunday. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following the conclusion of judging on Sunday. No dogs are allowed in the building overnight.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIANS' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

CRATING IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. Private exercise pens will not be allowed in the building. There will be NO space for un-entered dogs at these trials.

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED in the lobby, restrooms or concession area of the recreation complex.

MOVE-UPS WILL BE ALLOWED at this trial per AKC Regulations, provided that written notification is made to the Trial Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the trial.

Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

DOGS NEED BE PRESENT ONLY AT THE SCHEDULED TIME OF JUDGING according to the judging program that will be mailed to exhibitors. Dogs will be excused unless needed for further competition.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All American Dog/Mixed Breed". Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

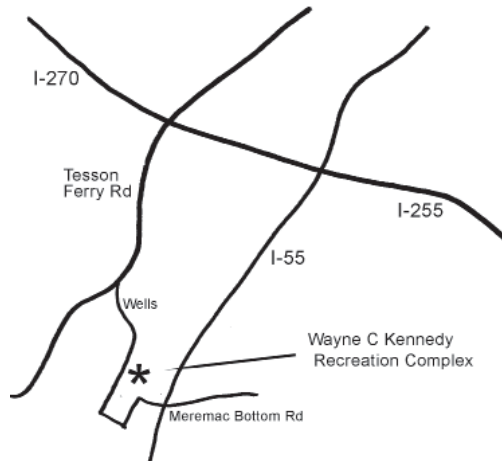
