Notice to Exhibitors

- THE SHOW SITE will be available on Thursday, October 11, 2012 between 2:00 pm and 8:00 pm. Friday doors open at 7:30 am. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following the conclusion of the judging on Sunday, October 14, 2012.
- CRATING IN DESIGNATED AREA ONLY. 3000 square feet air conditioned crating space available. Private x-pens will not be allowed in the building.

SMOKING is not allowed within the building.

- FOOD CONCESSIONS are not available at this facility. There are several restaurants located close to the facility. Food may be brought into the facility.
- DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED in restrooms or office area.
- DOGS ARE TO BE EXERCISED in specifically marked areas only. Owners must pick up after their dogs.
- TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, FAX AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES several days in advance of the closing date. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practical with entry identification cards and judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary. MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO MCOTC.
- A RECORDING FEE of \$0.50 and a \$3.00 Event Service Fee will be required for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2 Rules Applying to Dog Shows)
- A RECORDING FEE of \$3.00 will be required for each entry of each dog entered in any Rally Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 1, Section 3 Rally Regulations). These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club
- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred form competition by action of Obedience Trial Committee If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, tornadoes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry will be made.
- POST DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. THERE WILL BE NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.
- ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. PLEASE PRINT PLAINLY OR TYPEWRITE all information on your entry to help avoid errors.
- CATALOGS can be preordered for \$3.00 each. Prepaid catalogs will be available at the secretary's table. A small number of catalogs may be available the day of the trial for \$4.00 each.
- DOGS NEED BE PRESENT only at their scheduled time of judging according to the judging schedule. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring at their scheduled time. Judges will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule.
- ALL DOGS WILL BE KEPT ON A LEASH being held by the handler except when in the obedience ring, designated warm-up area, or exercise area. The superintendent, event secretary, and members of the Event Committee shall be responsible for compliance with this section and shall investigate any reports of infractions. (American Kennel Club Rule, Obedience Regulations Chapter 2, Section 26).

- ALL TROPHIES must be claimed at the show. If not, they become the property of the Show Giving Club. NO TROPHIES will be mailed.
- MOUND CITY OBEDIENCE TRAINING CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT to substitute trophies and or prizes with ones of equal or greater value.
- BITCHES IN SEASON (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete (American Kennel Club Obedience Regulation, Chapter 1 Section 18). A refund of entry fee, less \$5.00, will be made for a bitch who comes in season provided the Trial Secretary is notified PRIOR TO THE START OF THE TRIAL and VERIFIED IN WRITING BY A VETERINARIAN.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Mound City Obedience Training Club, and its members and Dog Sports at Kim's assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Mound City Obedience Training Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Jump Height Order

Obedience classes will be run short-to-tall on Friday, tall-to-short on Saturday and short-totall on Sunday.

Rally classes will be run short-to-tall on Friday and tall-to-short on Saturday.

Transfers

Transfers will be allowed according to AKC Regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
