- Entries cannot be changed (except for transfers) once the trial has closed. Please check your entries!

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Jump Height Order

All Obedience classes with jumps will be run in jump height order. Saturday will start with 4" dogs and run to 36". Sunday will start with 18" dogs, running up to 36" and then running from 4" to 16". Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

Transfers

Transfers will be allowed according to AKC Regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Notice to Exhibitors

SHOW SITE will be available from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM on Saturday and 7:00 AM to show close on Sunday.

OVERNIGHT PARKING will be permitted in the parking lot Friday and Saturday night, but no hook-ups or facilities are available.

NORTH ST. LOUIS COUNTY OTC, its members and Westinn Kennels assume no responsibility for loss, theft, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, or any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

EXHIBITORS should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11 Section 2). These fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

ALL ENTRIES must be submitted on official AKC entry forms, one dog per entry form.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entries must be received in writing or by email prior to close of entries.

CONDITIONAL ENTRIES. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause which is beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute valid entry fees.

BITCHES COMING INTO SEASON after close will receive a refund of their entry fee less \$8.00 per day entered provided the trial secretary is notified prior to the start of the trial and written verification is provided by a veterinarian.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING WHEN CALLED TO THE RING. Neither the club nor any ring steward will be obliged to call or notify exhibitors of when they are due in the ring for judging. Judges are not required to wait for any dog.

ALL CELL PHONES must be turned OFF when in the show building except the emergency cell phone located at the secretary's table, 314-954-5951.

NCOTC reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value.

TRANSFERS will be allowed per AKC regulations, provided that a written or email request is made to the Trial Secretary at least one-half hour prior the start of the trial.

Dogs On Leash:


All dogs must remain on leash when on the premises or within the adjoining area, unless working within a designated training or showing area.



2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTEN-DANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION. INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety your are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 inches, over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired); Collies (rough, smooth); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All American Dog/Mixed Breed". Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
