Jump Height Order

Obedience classes with jumps will be run as follows.

Friday will run tall-to-short starting with 36" jump height.

Saturday will run tall-to-short starting with 20" jump height.

Sunday will run tall-to-short starting with 16" jump height.

Rally classes with jumps will be run tall-to-short all days.

Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

Transfers

Transfers will be allowed according to AKC Regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Trial Information

The building will be available at 1:00 pm on Thursday for set-up and the OC Match.

Crating space is limited. Please restrict your crate space to the minimum required for your dogs.

There will be no crating space available for unentered dogs.

Concessions

Lunch will be available for purchase at the trial site, provided by the Greater St Louis Shetland Sheepdog Club.

Awards

A qualifying score is required for all awards.

Ribbons/Rosettes

Rosettes will be awarded to all placements in the Obedience 'A' classes and Rally classes.
Ribbons will be awarded to all placements in the 'B' classes and Optional Titling classes.
Ribbons will be awarded to all qualifiers.

Participation is limited to only those dogs entered in our trials.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.

Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience or Rally Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring.

Exhibitors are responsible for being ready for judging when called to the ring. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete back of form.

All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times. Warm-up must be done on lead.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC events.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at the show site and at all hotels, motels, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri, their Board, Members, and WestInn Kennels and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

NO SMOKING is permitted in WestInn Kennels.

DOGS NOT OWNED OR HANDLED BY EXHIBITORS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE TRAINING ROOM AT THESE TRIALS.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested with Tri-County Agility Club of Missouri, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club.

Photographs and/or video recordings taken for any reason other than personal use are strictly prohibited.

No SOLICITATION permitted on the trial site.

WESTINN KENNEL RULES

By entering this facility I hereby waive, release, and discharge any and all claims for personal injury and/or property damage which I may have or which I may subsequently have against WESTINN, Inc., its officers, and/or any other person associated with WESTINN, Inc., and/or Sharon West and/or Jerry West as a result of my use of the property. Damage to or Loss of Property to Renter and Participants:

During the course of the event, WESTINN, Inc. is not responsible for damage to or loss of property owned by the Renter and Participants whole on the premises and adjacent areas. Renter and Participants are responsible for taking prudent steps to safeguard their personal property during the Event.

Aggressive Dogs:

To foster a safe environment, aggressive dogs that are not controlled or controllable will be banned from the premises at the sole discretion of WESTINN, Inc. management and associated instructors. If a Participant's dog tends to be aggressive, he/she is responsible for notifying others and taking all prudent steps to prevent an incident, including voluntarily leaving the premises.

Dogs On Leash:

All dogs must remain on leash when on the premises or within the adjoining area, unless working within a designated training or showing area.

Dependents:

Anyone ages 8-17 years participating in an Event must have a parent or responsible adult in attendance at all times. Disabled dependents and children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible non-participating adult. **NO CHILDREN (OF ANY AGE) OR DISABLED DEPENDENTS ARE ALLOWED TO PLAY OR LOITER IN THE AREAS OUTSIDE OF THE WESTINN BUILDING.** Patrons who do not supervise the children in their care or who fail to observe these policies will be banned from the premises. If the Patron's children or dependents tend to pose a risk to themselves or others, or if their behavior is distracting to others and their dogs, they should not be brought to WESTINN or the adjacent parking area.

FROM THE EAST: I-70 west to Exit 208. Turn left at end of ramp. At the end of the overpass, turn right onto the South Service Road. Turn left on Swantnerville Dr (0.5 mi). WestInn Kennel is 500 feet down on the left.

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV, campgrounds and show grounds. All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds are considered within the show grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the show-giving club and its Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities.
