All entries must be submitted on official AKC Herding entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries!**

### Entry Process

The Farm Dog Certification will have a preference for Standard Schnauzers for the first 2 weeks. Entries for all other breeds will be put on a waiting list in order of receipt. On Feb 18, those entries will be put into the event until the limits are reached. Entries received after Feb 18 will be accepted in order of receipt, regardless of breeds, until the limit is reached. Day of show entries will be accepted until 8 am for the Farm Dog Certifications only.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

The Herding Tests and Trials are open to Standard Schnauzers only which have been registered with the American Kennel Club or have been granted a PAL/ILP number and are nine (9) months of age or older. Farm Dog Certification is open to all AKC-recognized breeds and mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

### Livestock

Sheep: Katahdin & Cross. Value: \$175 per head. There will be 3-5 head per run on A course and in all test classes.

Ducks: Call. Value: \$50 per head. There will be five head per run in all classes and on all courses.

### Trial Information

Trial hours are 7:00 am until 30 minutes after the completion of judging. Please bring your own chairs and water for your dog.

### **Notice to Exhibitors**

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

The Standard Schnauzer Club of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The Standard Schnauzer Club of America has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Bitches in season will be eligible and will run at the end of the class. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times except when in the area. Dogs must wear a simple well-fitting buckle, snap lock, or slip collar (no tags) or may work without a collar at Trial levels.

Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test or trial will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

The Standard Schnauzer Club of America, its Boards and Members, and Nestlé Purina Farms and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

The Standard Schnauzer Club of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.




## Directions
